Gregg Sweeps to convincing win in May 30/30 Event

Dusting off his quick chess skills, **Alan Gregg** sailed through the opposition with nary a scratch, although he was nicked for a couple of rating points in a first place finish at the first quick chess tournament hosted at the PHCC in a long while. Second place finishers turned out to be the dynamic duo of **Wilkinson** and **Morabito**...although it is tough to determine who is Batman and who is Robin. Utilizing their super powers both left a trail of destruction in their wake, remaining unscathed by the specter of defeat much like their hero: **Super Alan of Crosswell**. The rest of the dregs of Gotham feebly floundered through the three round Swiss barely managing to break even.

The highlight of this May's contest were its two time controls, the initial stanza required contestants to complete 30 moves within 30 minutes, followed by a 5 minute SD time frame with no delay built in to either. It turns out that the ever-intrepid Sarnian, Avery Jones, was the only victim of such rapid recreation as he overstepped time controls against Lon while being a clear piece to the good. PHCC's very own Yoda, **Stew Wilkinson**, cruised through the competition on his way to a resounding 4.5/5 point performance in the first "Gregg-less" event in quite some time. Being nicked for a draw by Lon in the first round, the

Stalwart Wilkinson capitalized on his opening and endgame prowess to power his way past the remaining competition with four consecutive wins, despite providing a handful of opportunities for his opponents to capitalize on some middle game miscues. **Matt Morabito** and **Lon Rutkofske** tied for second place honors, and for Lon, it was the first tournament in many a moon where he did not lose a game...although he tried his best to give games away to Matt and **Noel Bedy**. **Bill Wingrove** tossed away some major points as well, managing only a pair of draws for his efforts, despite achieving promising positions in the majority of his games.

Ironically, **Avery Jones**, Sarnia's superhero of the 2014 PHCC Championships stumbled badly in this event, returning many of the points he garnered by his insightful, consistent play in that event.

Local players will have to wait until August when the PHCC unveils its new tournament cycle. Hopefully, it will permit them to lick their wounds and prepare new, even more devastating tricks for both worthy opponents and perennial nemeses.

[Under extreme time pressure (I had less than a minute left and Stew had in excess of 5 minutes), I made the text move. In making the move, I accidentally knocked over both my queen, my rook and the b pawn. In my haste, I replaced the pieces as rapidly as possible and pushed my clock, inadvertently placing my Q on b1, neither of us realizing my error. With my Queen on b1, play continued 48.Qe3 Rg1+ 49.Kf3 Qf5+ 50.Qf4 Qd3+ 51.Re3 Qd1+ 52.Re2 Qd3+ 53.Re3 Qd1+ 54.Ke4 Rg4 55.Qxg4 Qxg4+ 56.Kd3 Qd1+ and White lost on time! In the process of reviewing the game score in the wee hours of Friday morning, it became evident that there was a discrepancy between our score sheets. On move 47 I recorded Qa1 and Stew had Qb1. By rule, if this happens, White would have two moves to rectify the position or the game continues. Also by rule, once a player has less than 5 minutes, he is no longer obliged to keep score. Additionally, his opponent is no longer required to keep score. I received confirmation of my suspicions in a chat with Noel Body while playing chess in St. Clair the following Saturday. As much as I wanted the win over Stew (I had not defeated him in a serious game since 1990), in good conscience I just could not take the win

under these circumstances and called Stew Saturday evening, related the situation and offered him a draw. He accepted. Let the controversy begin! According to Fritz 12, after I get my Q to b1, the position is equal, although White is ahead two pawns, his K is exposed to merciless attack and mating threats.] ½-½

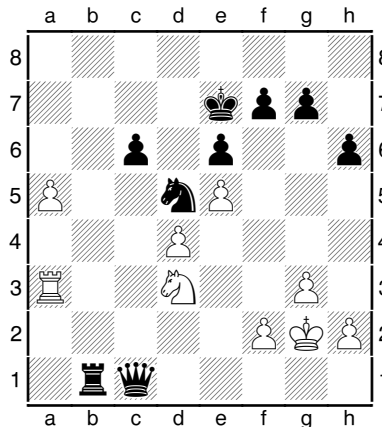

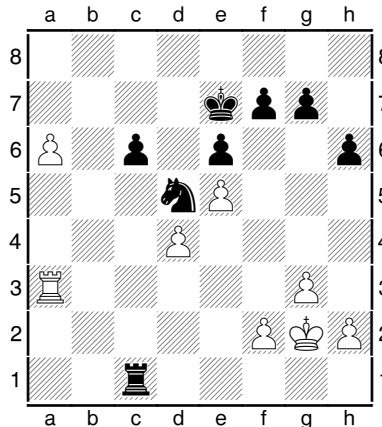

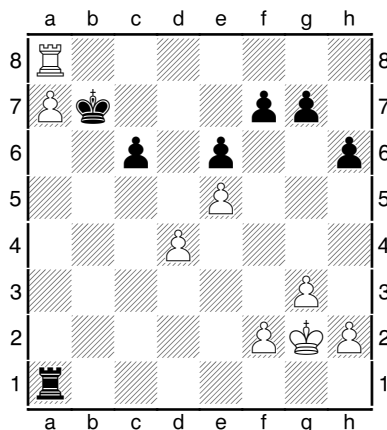
