



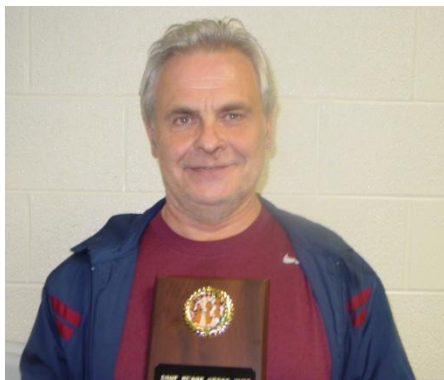

Bruziewicz captures 10th PHCC Speed Title



Canadian expert, **Andy Bruziewicz** dominated play in route to his 10th PHCC Speed Championship crown, running the table without a loss and outdistancing second place finishers **Alan Gregg** and **Eric Roome** who garnered 8 points each in the double round robin tilt. The Sarnia alderman who holds a number of significant government positions was free this particular Thursday evening, much to the dismay of the eager troupe of 6 would be champions, was not seriously threatened throughout the event, yielding a pair of final round "grandmaster draws" to Alan Gregg once the tournament was well out of reach of the other competitors. Notorious locally for his prowess at blitz chess, Andy is not adverse to granting time odds to most local players as a means of picking up a few quarters for the coffee machine at City Hall! His 11/12 point finish is also a club record for most wins in a championship event. **Lon Rutkofske**, last year's champion finished a dismal 6th place with erratic and less than creative play, not to mention the fact that he lost most of his games on time. **Eric Roome** kept pace with the leaders for most of the way, upending Alan in a two game sweep in the first round, but dropping a pair to Andy in the second round. **Tony West** dropped by on the rainy Thursday evening from the dry and warm environs of his home in Grosse Pointe Woods to add to the drama and strength of the PHCC's 36th 5-minute Blitz Championship tying **Matt Morabtio** with 5.5 points. Finally, what began with an exasperating series of unanticipated delays at the Blue Water Bridge and ended in a devastating evening with and 0.0 performance over the board, **Avery Jones** remained remarkably philosophical and upbeat as he and Andy headed home in the cool fall drizzle.
