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## **Gregg notches 1<sup>st</sup> place prize in *Over 1600* section as Bedy goes undefeated to capture *Under 1600* first place cash in 2018 July Mini-Swiss**

His chances were never in jeopardy considering Lon blundered a queen to **Josh Muir** (His first tournament win against Lon.) literally snatching defeat out of the jaws of victory and losing the “heart” to play well against **Matt Morabito** in a crushing defeat. I guess now Lon can commiserate with Alan in his loss to Greg Bailey in the recent MI Senior Tournament.

The *Under 1600* section featured a final round battle between **Noel Bedy** and **Avery Jones** whereby the St. Clair native skillfully demonstrated some superb endgame play upending the Sarnian to claim the first place cash! It also didn't hurt that his winnings were destined to serve a greater cause. This unexpected windfall facilitated his plan for a dinner date to celebrate his anniversary the following week!! **Bill Wingrove** enjoyed the dubious distinction and frustration of sharing with Lon a place in the short end of standings by dropping a final round decision to **Gerrit Beneker** in a nicely played game. In a significant aside an excited Avery Jones, in the midst of a intense ending with Noel, approached Bill and I with the vociferous observation about the improvement of Gerrit's play, insisting that “ he has to be studying, because increased quality of his play has been no less than spectacular!” citing his first round escape from his lower rated opponent despite dropping a piece!

The tournament was also remarkable in that it was the first time since 1996 that the PHCC has enjoyed the participation of a female contestant in the form of 10 year old **Daniela Kovatch** who participated in her first ever USCF rated event! Bravo to you, Dani for rising to the challenge and being totally unintimidated by the aging, albeit encouraging crew of PHCC regulars!

Unfortunately **Niko Pirouz's** late arrival caused the PHCC newbie some distress, as the tournament was already underway, and he was unable to participate.

## Dues News:

While dues are not required for anyone interested in playing at the club, they are required for those competing in tournament play. Annual Dues are \$20.00 for adults and \$10.00 for those under 19. Dues funds are used to offset miscellaneous expenses not funded by the Recreation Department. United States Chess Federation memberships are available through the club.

## Calendar of Events:

**First Thursday of Each Month** - Chess Clinics- 6:30 to 7:00 PM - \$7.50 per person. From 7:00 until 10:00. Players wishing to play Challenge matches with longer time controls of G/60 with 5 sec delay can choose to play match games if they so desire. Participants will be required to follow the rules and regulations for **Challenge Play** (As outlined in Chess Chatter, our website under "Club Member Ratings Lists", or posted at the club.) and colors will be selected by lot. PHCC club ratings will be used. Players should turn their game scores into Lon, so he can adjust ratings appropriately and showcase the games in *Chess Chatter*. **Monthly Tournaments** will be held, usually on the third Thursday of the month, See the events schedule below for specifics!

## 2018 Events Schedule:

**August 9, 16, 23 – USCF/PHCC Rated Mini-Swiss ( or Quads based on entries)** 3 Round- USCF Rated Mini-Swiss. Game/90 minutes with/5 sec. delay. USCF and PHCC membership required. One game per night (August 9, 16 & 23)! Play will begin at 7:00PM. EF: \$5.00 Play will begin at 7:00PM. A minimum of 4 participants are required. Prizes: based on entries. Please register in advance by contacting Lon Rutkofske by August 8th so he can determine if there are enough entries to hold the event.

**September 20<sup>th</sup> – PHCC rated Thematic tournament: G/25 with 3 sec. delay** EF: \$5.00 ...Prizes based on entries. A minimum of 4 participants will be necessary to hold the event. Please contact Lon via phone or email if you plan to register. Onsite registration 6:30-7:00PM - Play begins at 7:00 PM. Prizes: if Quad: 1st = \$15; if Mini-Swiss: Based on entries! (Recording games is optional, for players that wish to keep score, neither player is required to keep score if either has 5 minutes or less on their clock.) Players with the white pieces will be playing a game with a predetermined opening sequence such as the Ruy Lopez, or KI Attack based on one of the openings drawn at random by the TD. The game will begin from that opening position.

**October 18<sup>th</sup> PHCC Speed Championships** - The Port Huron Chess Club's 37<sup>th</sup> Annual Speed Championship Tournament will be held on Thursday, October 18<sup>th</sup> beginning at 7:00 PM. Registrations will determine the number of rounds and prizes. PHCC membership required. Entry fee will be \$5.00. Please contact Lon if you plan to play. There will be no registrations on-site. If you intend to play, contact Lon before October 18<sup>th</sup>.

**November 15<sup>th</sup> – Duncan's 18<sup>th</sup> Turkey Gobbler Tournament "fun tournament":** 6 rounds – featuring handicap speed, fixed positions, pre-selected openings, problem solving, G/15 events. EF\$ 5.00, prizes based on entries; Plaque for over-all champion: class prizes for each section (A fun event created by Bob Duncan in 1980.) ! A minimum of 4 participants will be necessary to hold the event. Please contact Lon via phone or email if you plan to register. Play begins at 7:00 PM.
